# Statement of Faith

A. We believe in one eternal God, the creator and upholder of all things in Jesus Christ, His Son, and in the Holy Ghost, and that these three are one (Matthew 28:19; I John :7; II Corinthians 13:14).

B. We believe the holy scriptures of the Old and New Testaments to be the Word of God, and the only rule of faith and practice (II Timothy 3:16-17; II Peter 1: 20-21). The King James Version of the Bible shall be the official and only translation used by the Association.

C. We believe that man is unable to recover himself from the fallen state that he is in by reason of sin, only by the grace of God through the exercise of faith (Ephesians 2:1-2; 2:5,8; Romans 3:22-23; I Corinthians 15:22).

D. We believe that baptism, the Lord's Supper and the washing of the saint's feet are ordinances of Jesus Christ and that immersion is the only mode of baptism; not putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God by the resurrection of Jesus Christ (John 13: 12-17; I Corinthians 11:24; I Peter 3:21).

E. We believe that no minister has the right to administer these ordinances except such as are regularly ordained (II Timothy 1:6).

F. We believe in the resurrection of the dead, a general judgment, the punishment of the wicked, and the joys of the righteous are eternal (Daniel 12:2; John 5:28-29; II Corinthians 5:10; II Thessalonians 1:8-9; Romans 6:23).

G. We believe according to the scriptures - Paul's letter to the Hebrews 6:1-7 and other scriptures - that after a man has been partaker of the Holy Ghost, it is possible to fall away and forever be lost.

H. Membership into the Free Will Christian Baptist Church of Christ is extended to all who have had and whose lives evidence a genuine experience of regeneration through faith in and acceptance of the Lord Jesus Christ as personal savior (Acts 2:46).

I. We believe that no persons are members of the church of Christ, only those who have the witness within themselves (Romans 8:14-17).

J. We believe that all members of the church of Christ have a right to the sacramental table upon the principles of their acceptance with him for Saint Paul says, "But let man examine himself, and so let him eat of the bread and drink of the cup." (I Corinthians 11:28).

K. We believe that homosexuality is a sin and shall not be taught or practiced by the churches of this Association (Romans 1:21-32).

L. We believe and teach that a woman should not be ordained as a minister or deacon according to scripture that a woman should not teach or usurp authority over the man (I Timothy 2:12)

Bro Moderator brought up the letter M. in the Statement of Faith for discussion and seeking scriptural support.

\*Bro Bill Montandon also mentioned it was a good rule but should be moved to Presbytery rules.

\*Bro Tracy Blankenship likes the rules and mentioned Isaiah 47:2-3 defines an uncovered thigh as naked.

\*Bro Jeff Clayborn also spoke to it.

\*Bro Harold Robinson reminded us tht Adam and Eve covered themselves when they realized they were naked.

\*Bro Ray Young gave caution as to judging and making rules but agreed with how we should dress.

\*Bro Carl Sullivan also spoke seeing this in the today's churches.

\* Bro Frank Davis and Bro Danny Bandy reminded us that this is to our ordained authority and doesn't ask much.

\*Bro Jerry Mayberry mentioned this should be addressed by the Presbytery. It is for them and should be in the Presbytery rules.

\*Bro Tex Bolesgave more caution to giving a hindrance to the Gospel.

.Bro Frank Davis as acting Presbytery Moderator took the podium to elect members of the committee for the coming year. Bro Bill Montandon; Bro Frank Davis; Bro Ed Shaver; Bro Tracy Blankenship; Bro Johnathan Hankins; Bro Jeff Clayborn; and Bro Jon Baker volunteered to serve. The Assistant Clerk took the vote to accept the Committee as volunteered.

Bro Moderator asked for any new business.

Bro Bill Montandon mentioned Antioch FWB concerning confusion over their Church letter and suggested Home Missions make contact and possibly Promotional Director.

Motion was made to send Promotional Director, motion passed.

Sis Peggy Welch mentioned problems in the bathrooms. Association Committee is already working on a solution.

Bro Moderator brought back the letter M. in the Statement of Faith issue asking for scripture and comments.

\*Bro Charles West said several good men have been disqualified by this rule. Only see it as a hindrance.

\*Bro Carl Sullivan mentioned the style of shorts some are wearing.

\*Bro Ed Shaver mentioned that Douglas Chapel pulled out stating "It is un-Biblical".

\*Sis Darlene Jones was glad this was brought up and suggested a re-wording to "modest apparel" to be scriptural.

\*Bro Carl Sullivan spoke to convictions as personal.

\*Bro Dow Allen said he would hate it to hinder the Association, this is a personal opinion. Having read as much as he could from Bible and history said we had no authority and are without scripture. Would remove "shall" and put "recommend".

\*Sis Peggy Welch spoke of the un-churched children who came wearing shorts but the example of the church to them is important.

\*Bro Jerry Maberry remembered when the motion was put up and voted on and lives in accordance to the rule but believes it is personal preference but this will cost more churches and glad this was done this way but now we need to vote.

\*Bro Roger Young said this man-made rule is costly.

\*Bro Bill Montandon said after 30 minutes of talking we still have no scripture. It needs moving and re-writing, the Statement of Faith was about Salvation.

\*Bro Phillip Nash said this is a personal thing.

\*Sis Cindy Halluns knew growing up how to dress and said they need more deacons and thinks that as long as the shorts are modest there should be no problem.

\*Sis Darlene Jones said that Mt. Pleasant dealt with this years ago. Bro Charles West simply asked people to dress different and all was ok.

\*Bro Roger Young said if handled God's way, God will handle it.

\*Bro Tex Boles asked how many churches have been lost (no one was sure).

\*Bro Bill Montandon made a motion to:

1. Move the rule to the Presbytery Rules.

2. Re-word as "All Presbytery members are expected to dress in a style of Biblical modesty that glorifies the Lord Jesus Christ." Motion was seconded.

Bro Moderator said vote would happen on Saturday and require a 2/3 majority vote. Motion to adjourn to worship.

Bro. Johnathan Hankins called for singers. Sis Darlene Jones; Sis Sybil Baker; Bro Roger Young; and Sis Cindy Halluns all sang.

Bro Johnathan Hankins asked for prayer requests. We were led by Bro Jeff Clayborn.

Bro. Danny Bandy came to preach. He read Mark 4:35-5:8 and preached on the topic "God's Power".
